

HUNGARY**Women's programmes**

In the Hungarian Prisons there are no specific programmes for women who have suffered gender violence within intimate partnerships and are in prison.

Men's programmes

In the Hungarian Prisons there are no specific programmes for men who have committed gender violence within intimate partnerships and are in prison.

Recently there has been an initiative to elaborate and provide treatment programmes for sexual offenders. In 2007 a pilot-project was started in 3 prisons involving 15 inmates (5 of them were in pre-trial detention, 5 of them were juvenile and 5 of them were adult inmates).

On the other hand, the Probation Service is responsible for the after-care of ex-offenders released from prisons and juveniles released from reformatories but they neither have special standards nor means for the follow-up of these offenders. However, in the pre-sentence report the probation officer may suggest the order of special behaviour rule in the case of sexual offenders to prevent re-offending (e.g. regular meetings with a psychologist or prohibition to meet the victim).
